(a) (i) with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in the pay band-2, ₹ 9300-34800 with grade pay of ₹4200 or equivalent in the parent cadre or department;

Provided that in case such eligible officers have retired or have been transferred to reserve before the actual selection to the post is made, their appointment will be on re-employment basis.

Note 1: Period of deputation (ISTC) including period of deputation in another *ex-cadre* post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

Note 2: For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, to service rendered on a regular basis by an effect prior to the 1st January, 2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the said Pay Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.
