## MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS

G.S.R. 448.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the provisio to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Life Guard, Pump Operator and Plumber (Group 'C' posts) in the North Eastern Police Academy, Barapani, Shillong, Ministry of Home Affairs namely:-

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the North Eastern Police Academy, Barapani (Life Guard, Plumber and Pump Operator) Group 'C' Posts, Recruitment Rules, 2017.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matirx.—The number of posts, their classification and the level in the pay matirx attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.
- 4. Disqualification.—No person,
  - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
  - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Serviceman and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
